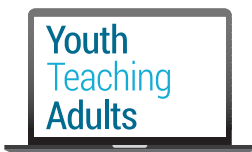

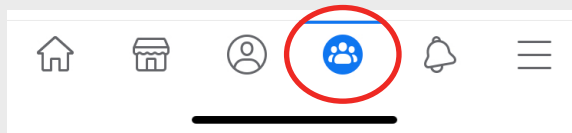

Find the Facebook app

- Look for the Facebook app on your device's home screen or in the app launcher
- Tap on the Facebook app to open it
- If Facebook isn't installed on your device, open the Google Play Store. You can search for "Facebook" and download the app. If you've never downloaded apps before, do [this lesson](#) first. If you've never used Facebook before, do [this lesson](#) first.

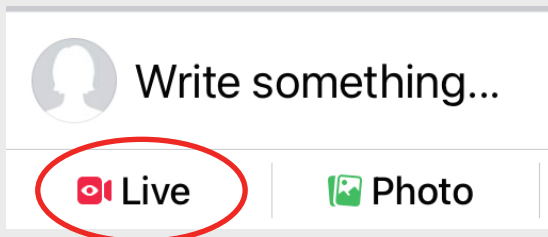

Open your Facebook Group

- Click on the **Groups** icon at the top of the Facebook page. Then, open your Facebook Group.
- If you've never used Facebook Groups before, do [this lesson](#) first

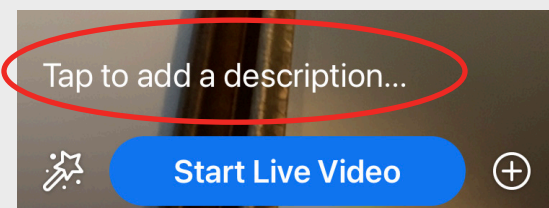

Facebook Live

- You can use Facebook Live to stream live video of your lesson to your learners. To do this, you'll need to use a phone or tablet with a camera to film yourself teaching.
- Tap **Live** to open Facebook Live

Start a live video

- Your phone may ask you to give Facebook permission to access your microphone and camera. If it does ask, tap **Allow**.
- You can add a description to your live video stream by tapping **Tap to add a description**. Type your description, then tap **Done**.
- When you're ready to start broadcasting, tap **Start Live Video**. Everyone in your group will see you've started a live video and can start watching it.

Switch cameras

- If your device has more than one camera, you can switch between cameras by tapping on the **Switch Camera** icon
- Switching cameras is useful if you want to show your learners someone else, like another person or an object

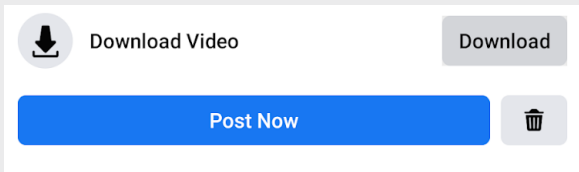

Use your camera light

- If your device has a flashlight, you'll be able to turn on the light by tapping on the **Light** icon
- The light is useful if your video is too dark for your viewers to see it well

Post your video

- You can end your live video by tapping **Finish**
- After you've ended a live video, you can post a copy of your video to your Facebook Group so that group members can watch it later. To do this, tap **Post Now**. You can choose to have Facebook automatically delete your video after 30 days.
- If you don't want to post a copy of your video to your group, tap the **Trash** icon on the bottom right of the screen
