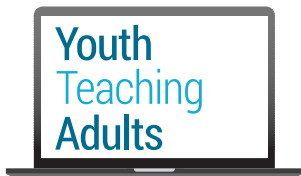
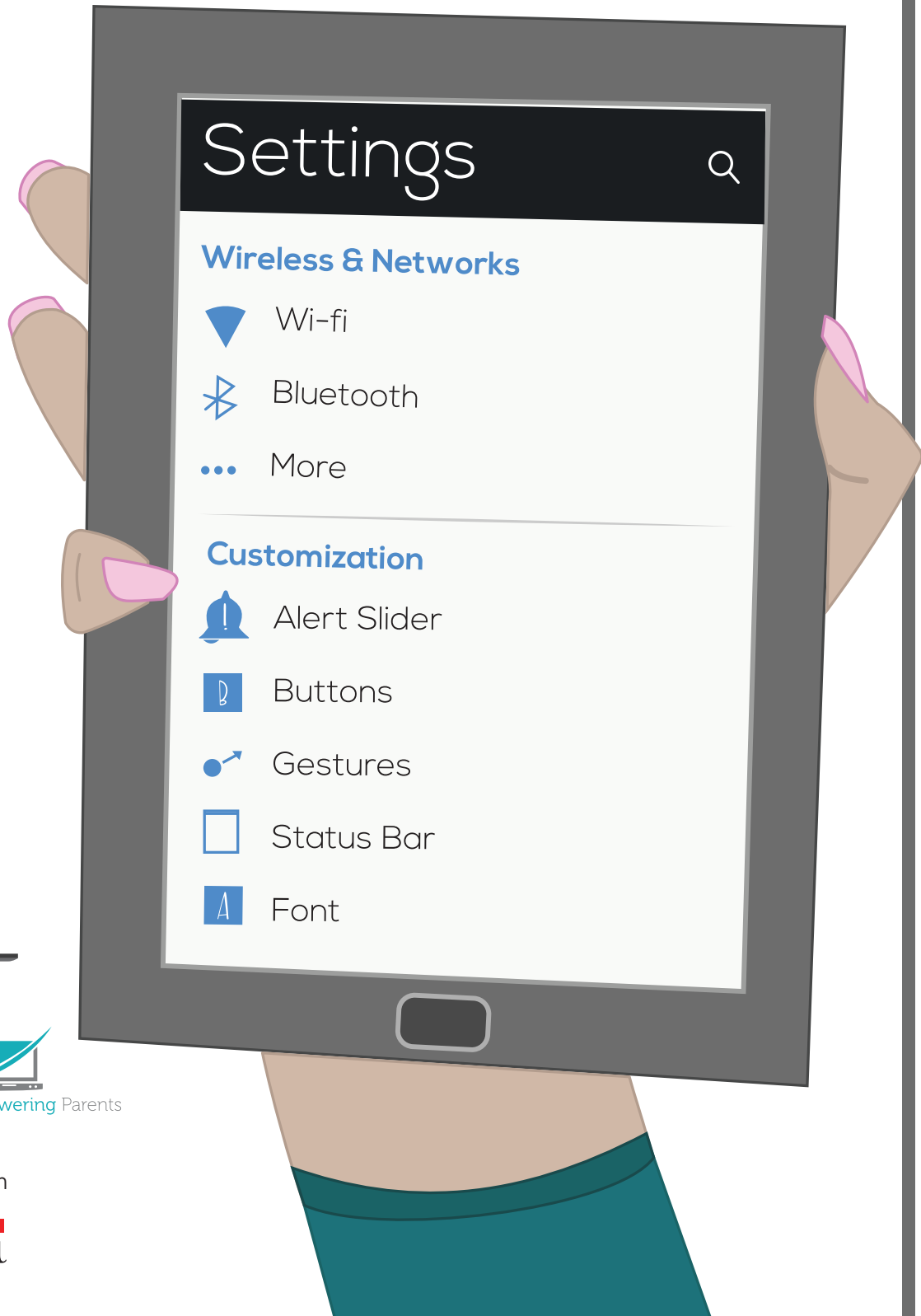

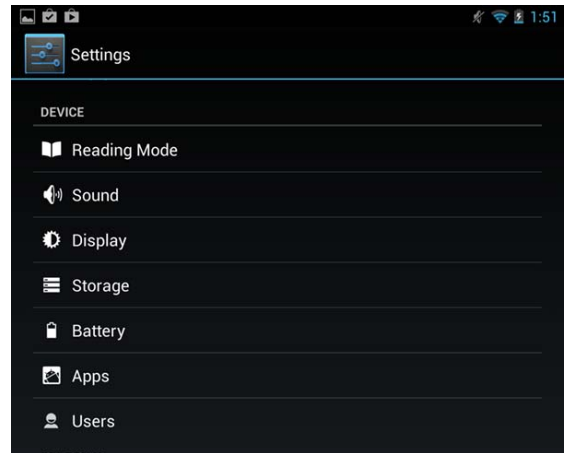
Open Settings



- Ask your adult learner to find the settings icon. They can look for it on the home screen or in the app launcher.
- Ask your adult learner to tap on the settings icon to open it

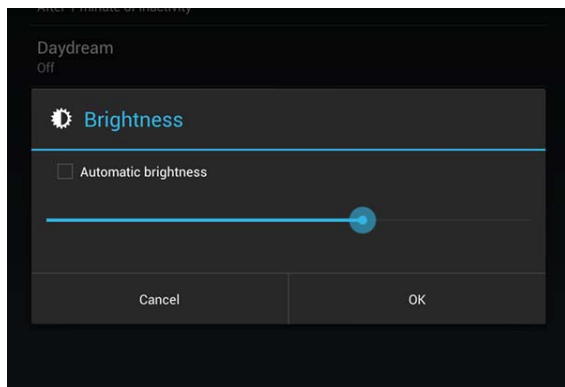
View the Settings menu



- Explain to your adult learner that the settings menu lets them change things on their device, like:
 - ↳ volume
 - ↳ screen brightness
 - ↳ text size

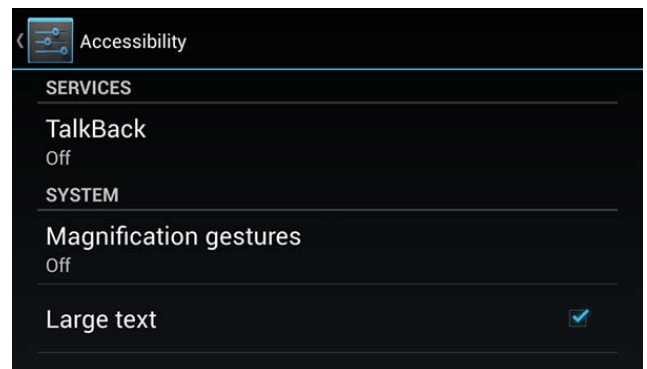
Adjust the brightness and volume



- Ask your adult learner to tap on **Display**. Then ask them to change the screen brightness.
- Explain that the brighter the screen is, the better they can see it. But a brighter screen also drains the battery faster.
- Ask your adult learner to go back to the settings menu. Then ask them to tap on **Volume**.
- Explain what each volume control is for
- Ask them to adjust the volume for each control

Make the text larger



- Ask your adult learner to go back to the settings menu. Ask them to search for **Accessibility** and tap on it.
- Ask them to look for an option called **Large text** or **Font size**. Ask them to make the text larger or smaller.
- Explain to your adult learner that they can use this setting to change the text size. If they find it hard to read the screen, larger text can help.
